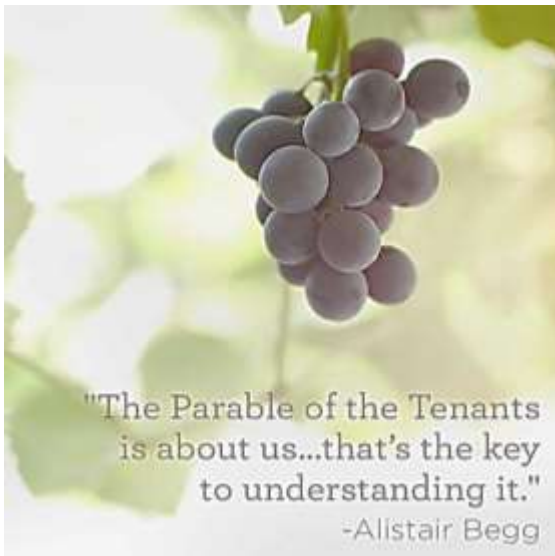

The Miracle of the Sun

The Miracle of the Sun that took place in Fatima, Portugal, on October 13, 1917 has been called the greatest miracle performed by God in the history of mankind since the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

As in the Resurrection, the miracle was announced several months prior to its fulfillment and occurred at the exact time and place announced by Our Lady of Fatima and was witnessed by over 70,000 people.

Next **Saturday, October 14th**, in recognition of the Miracle of the Sun, St. Joseph Parish in conjunction with America Needs Fatima will sponsor a program, led by Deacon Gies, of Adoration followed by a Rosary Rally.

The program will begin at 10:00 AM with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, followed by Benediction at 11:00 AM. Following Benediction we will process to the Grotto (weather permitting) where we hold the rosary rally and prayers. The rosary will be said for peace in the world, for families affected from recent disasters, both in the US and worldwide. Mark your calendars to attend all or part of this program.

Society of the Propagation of the Faith

The Society for the Propagation of the Faith was founded in Lyons, France, in 1822 by a young French laywoman, Pauline Jaricot. Inspired by stories she heard about missionary work in China, she felt called by the Lord to help the Catholic Church's worldwide missionary work. Pauline herself never traveled to the Missions, which, during her lifetime, consisted of the Missions in China - and young dioceses in the United States. Pauline gathered friends and workers in a family silk mill into "circles of ten," asking each person to pray daily for the Missions and sacrifice a penny-a-week (at that time, quite a large sacrifice!). From this idea emerged the Propagation of the Faith. Today the General Fund of the Propagation of the Faith, which gathers gifts from Catholics all over the world - a concept that originated with Pauline Jaricot and her desire to help all the world's missions - is the basic means of support for the Catholic Church's worldwide Missions.

World Mission Sunday, October 22

World Mission Sunday, our annual worldwide Eucharistic celebration for the Missions and missionaries of the world, will be on **October 22**. This collection on the next-to-last Sunday in October is a unique, global effort for the entire Church to provide for the building up of over one thousand local churches in Asia and Africa, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe. Through the work of these churches, and their witness to Christ, the poor receive practical help and experience God's love and mercy, His hope and peace.

This year, we are reminded by Pope Francis that **Mission is at the Heart of Christian Faith**; the materials for World Mission Sunday from the Society for the Propagation of the Faith encourage an ongoing formative relationship for mission, offering portraits of today's missionaries inspired by the words of our chief missionary, Pope Francis.
