The Miracle of the Sun

The Miracle of the Sun that took place in Fatima, Portugal, on October 13, 1917 has been called the greatest miracle performed by God in the history of mankind since the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

As in the Resurrection, the miracle was announced several months prior to its fulfillment and occurred at the exact time and place announced by Our Lady of Fatima and was witnessed by over 70,000 people.

On **Saturday, October 14th**, in recognition of the Miracle of the Sun, St. Joseph Parish in conjunction with America Needs Fatima will sponsor a program, led by Deacon Gies, of Adoration followed by a Rosary Rally. The program will begin at 10:00 AM with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, followed by Benediction at 11:00 AM. Following Benediction we will process to the Grotto (weather permitting) where we hold the rosary rally and prayers. The rosary will be said for peace in the world, for families affected from recent disasters, both in the US and worldwide. Mark your calendars to attend all or part of this program.

October is the Month of the Rosary

Pope Francis on Wednesday reminded the faithful that the month of **October** is dedicated to the **Rosary** and invited all believers to recite the Marian prayer.

In a tweet, on the day when the Church celebrates the feast of the Blessed Virgin of the Rosary, the Pope said "the Rosary is the prayer that always accompanies my life: it is also the prayer of simple people and saints...it is the prayer of my heart".

At the conclusion of the weekly General Audience, he explained that the Rosary is "a synthesis of Divine Mercy":

"With Mary, in the mysteries of the Rosary we contemplate the life of Jesus which irradiates the mercy of the Father. Let us rejoice in His love and forgiveness, let us recognize it in foreigners and in those who are needy, let us live His Gospel every day".

Pope Francis said: "May this simple Marian prayer show you, young people, the way to give life to God's will in your lives; dear sick people, love this prayer because it brings consolation for the mind and the heart; and dear newly wedded spouses, may it represent a privileged moment of spiritual intimacy within your new family".

Pope Francis gives all people he meets a Rosary. "Our Lady – he says – is always close to Her children and ready to help when we pray to her, when we ask for her protection... let us remember she is always ready to serve and never keeps anyone waiting".
