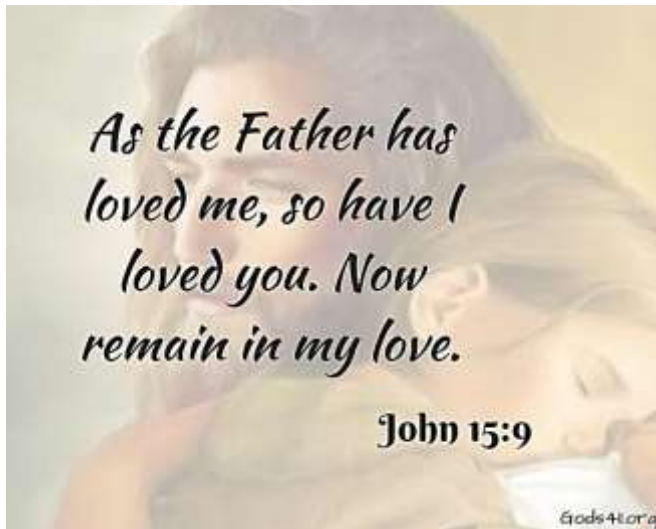

MORE INFO: The Most Reverend George V. Murry, S.J., Bishop of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Youngstown has been diagnosed with a form of acute leukemia. He was admitted to the Cleveland Clinic on Sunday, April 29, 2018. He will undergo intensive chemo therapy for the next four weeks.
