School Year

St. Joseph School provides formal education for pre-school (ages 3, 4, 5) through grade 8. The school year is divided into 4 grading periods. Interim reports (K-8) are given half way through each grading period and report cards at the end of each quarter. (Pre-8) The current school year consists of 178 days (K-8) and Labor Day – Memorial Day (Pre-school). The school day begins with prayer at 8:00 am and concludes at 2:30 pm. Before and after school care (latchkey) is offered for an additional charge. (Pre-8)
