Child Protection Training: Virtus Program

If you plan to work with children at St. Joseph School or St. Joseph Parish the Diocese of Youngstown requires that you:

- #1: Attend any Virtus Training Program anywhere in the diocese,
- #2: Have a BCI fingerprint either before or after the class and have a hardcopy sent to
St. Joseph School
2617 Waterloo Rd.
Mogadore, OH 44260

Note: If you have been fingerprinted and have continued to volunteer in the school and/or parish you do not need to be re-fingerprinted or attend another child protection class. (This policy may change in the near future.)

Fingerprinting is done at some BMV places, police stations, some public school board offices, etc. Call before you go to make sure the system is operational. The code number you need to give them for volunteers is 3319 39B1 non-teaching position.

Cost is \$35 - \$45, depending on the place.
