**Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**

The annual Triduum celebration of the Assumption of Mary, Mother of God is only three weeks away. This year the celebration falls on Monday, August 13, Tuesday, August 14, and the Holy Day, Wednesday, August 15.

There will be no morning Masses on Monday or Tuesday. The evening Masses will be at 7:00 PM in the Grotto, of course weather permitting.

As it stands there will be a **Communal Penance Service Monday evening at 6:30 PM** in the church and at its conclusion you will proceed to the Grotto for Mass. Fr. Pfeiffer and Fr. Lang will be present for the Penance Service. Fr. Pfeiffer be the celebrant at the Mass.

Tuesday evening will be Anointing of the Sick, again in the church at 6:30 PM. Fr. Lang will be present for this and he will also be the celebrant at the Mass.

On **Wednesday, August 15th**, the **Assumption Mass** will be at 7:00 PM with Fr. Tom Dyer as celebrant. Wednesday's Mass is a Holy Day of obligation.
