**NINTH ANNUAL FAITH & FAMILY FESTIVAL**

A day of fun and fulfillment for families, students and friends to be held on **Sunday, September 23, 2018**, on the West Quad of the campus of Walsh University at 2020 E. Maple St., North Canton. The day will begin at 11:00am with Mass, planned with Bishop Murry, and will feature local and nationally known musical acts, including polka artist Matt Schafer, Puerto Rican ensemble Conjunto Riquena, Gospel singer Felicia Landry and Christian rock band Remedy Drive. **TRIDUUM OF THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY, the MOTHER OF GOD**

The annual Triduum celebration of the Assumption of Mary, Mother of God into Heaven is only two and a half weeks away.

This year the celebration falls on:

Monday, August 13

Tuesday, August 14

Wednesday, August 15, the Holy Day.

*There will be no morning Masses on Monday or Tuesday.*

Monday evening presents a single Liturgy uniting the Sacrament of Penance (Communal form) in the church at 6:30 PM, then a processional to the Grotto altar of sacrifice for the Eucharistic celebration. Following this Liturgy there is a candlelight procession along the Stations of the Cross surrounding the Grotto. Fr. Pfeiffer is the main celebrant for this Liturgy and joins Fr. Lang and myself as ministers of this Sacrament.

Tuesday evening presents a single Liturgy uniting the Sacrament of the Sick in the church at 6:30 PM, then a processional to the Grotto altar of sacrifice for the Eucharistic celebration. Following this Liturgy there is a candlelight procession along the Stations of the Cross surrounding the Grotto. Fr. Lang is the main celebrant for this Liturgy and joins me as a minister of this Sacrament.

On **Wednesday, August 15<sup>th</sup>**, the **Assumption Mass** will be at 7:00 PM with Fr. Tom Dyer as celebrant. Following Mass will be the candlelight procession along the Stations of the Cross surrounding the Grotto. Wednesday's Mass is a Holy Day of obligation and opportunity.

**Gospel Reflection**

"There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?" (JOHN 6:9) The miracle of the Loaves and Fishes is the only miracle which is recorded six times in the Gospel. It carries two important messages. First, no matter how little we have, we always have enough to share. Second, Christ can take our humble gifts and do great things with them if we are just willing to let Him. No gift is too small or insignificant!
