CHRISM MASS

Parishioners from across the Diocese representing the 89 parishes, missions and schools in the six county Catholic Diocese of Youngstown will demonstrate the unity of the diocesan Church as they gather at the **Cathedral of Saint Columba** in Youngstown for the **Mass of Holy Chrism on Holy Tuesday April 12, at 10:30 a.m.** The Most Reverend David J. Bonnar will be principal celebrant. Priests concelebrating in the sanctuary will include Diocesan Consultors and Deans. Included in the Chrism Mass is the annual renewal of the diocesan and religious priests of their commitment to priestly service.

An additional focus of this Liturgy will be the consecration of the Sacred Chrism and blessing of the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Catechumens. At the close of Mass each pastor will receive Sacred Chrism and the other Holy Oils for use in their parish.

CTNY, the Catholic Television Network of Youngstown will live stream the Chrism Mass on the diocesan website: www.doy.org/live/ The Ecumenical Television Channel (ETC) through the services of CTNY will re-broadcast the Chrism Mass on Tuesday, April 12 at 8:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, April 13 at 10:00 a.m. It will also broadcast in the Stark County area on Thursday, April 14, at 10:00 p.m.

Diocesan Wedding Anniversary Celebrations

The Diocese of Youngstown is sponsoring a Wedding Anniversary Celebration on Sunday, May 8, 2:00 pm at St. Columba Cathedral in Youngstown.

The Celebration is for couples celebrating their 25th, 40th, 50th or over wedding anniversary. It will include Mass with Bishop David Bonnar, a renewal of marriage vows, a personalized certificate for each couple and a reception for the couple and their families. Couples may opt to attend the Wedding Anniversary Celebration Mass in person at St. Columba Cathedral or they may participate remotely via live-streaming on the diocesan website at www.doy.org. Limited spaces are available for couples at the Cathedral. You must make reservations in advance for this event by contacting your parish office as soon as possible.

Deadline for registration is April 6th.
