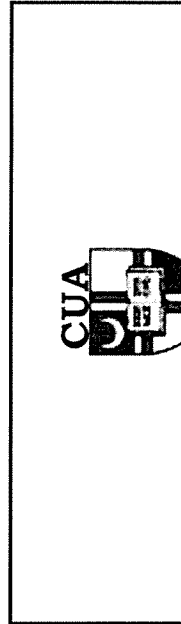

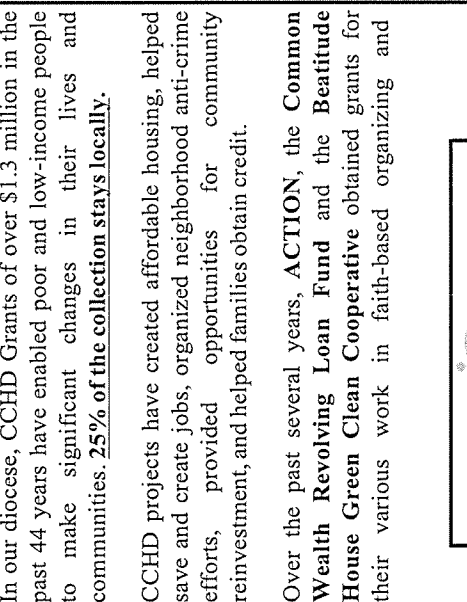
**Half the proceeds of the CCC collection stay in our diocese for CTNY productions and broadcasts of diocesan events.**

CCHD gives poor and low-income Americans hope to build a better life through self-help projects, giving community members a chance to work together to attack the root causes of poverty and injustice.

In our diocese, CCHD Grants of over \$1.3 million in the past 44 years have enabled poor and low-income people to make significant changes in their lives and communities. **25% of the collection stays locally.**

CCHD projects have created affordable housing, helped save and create jobs, organized neighborhood anti-crime efforts, provided opportunities for community reinvestment, and helped families obtain credit.

Over the past several years, **ACTION**, the **Common Wealth Revolving Loan Fund** and the **Beatitude House Green Clean Cooperative** obtained grants for their various work in faith-based organizing and
